

Getting to Ethical Consumer

By Train

Trains to/from Manchester Piccadilly are most frequent.

You can then either walk (around 30minutes) to our office, or you can take a taxi to Old Birley Street in Hulme. This should cost c. £4.50 and take around 10 minutes. Buses are available on Whitworth Street.

Trains to/from **Manchester Oxford Road** are less frequent.

It takes around 20 minutes to walk to our office. The best walking route is up Oxford Road. Then turn right just after the small park (Cavendish Street), follow the path straight on under a large building and through a courtyard. Cross Cambridge street and go down Stretford Rd. Over the Hulme arch (bridge) and left at the traffic lights down Old Birley Street. Look for George Parr Road on your left after about 200 yards.

By Bus

Old Birley Street is served by Bus Route 86 (Piccadilly Gardens to Chorlton Bus Station) Also Stretford Road (which meets the top of Old Birley Street) is served by Bus Routes 85, 250, 251, 256, 263

By Bicycle

By Car

If entering **Manchester from the South** you will be using the M56. This provides the easiest route to find the ECRA office. At the end of the M56 follow signs for the A5103 - Manchester City Centre. Follow this road for about three miles until you reach a large ASDA supermarket. Turn left just after the ASDA, and the turn right at the second set of traffic lights about 100 yards later. This will be Old Birley Street.

After about 400 yards you will reach the Junction Pub on the left and a large yellow brick building opposite on the right. This yellow brick building is 41 Old Birley Street. The main entrance is a large purple door opposite the Junction Pub. At this door walk clockwise round the building, and the first red door you come to will have a bell for the ECRA office.

Parking is available on George Parr Road (off Old Birley Street). **NB** this is limited to 2 hours, and no return after one hour.
